

CLOSET ENVY CONSIGNMENT EVENTS

Consignor Agreement & Release Form

This Agreement is made between Closet Envy Consignment ("CEC") and you ("Seller").

In consideration for the opportunity to participate and profit from the CEC Event the Seller/Consignor has read, understands and agrees to the following terms and conditions:

- Seller understands that CEC will do everything possible to prevent loss, damage, or theft, but in the case such an event occurs, the Seller does not hold CEC liable for the loss, damage, or theft of any items. Seller accepts all risk of lost, stolen or damaged items. Any items found without a tag during the sale will be placed in a Lost & Found and sellers can examine the Lost & Found at the end of the sale. Any items not claimed from Lost & Found will be donated to charity. Seller agrees to hold harmless and make no claims against CEC, Rebecca Craft, the lessor/lessee or owner of the space where the event is held, or any volunteers and/or paid participants involved at the event. The above parties are released from liability for any and all claims for damaged, stolen, or lost items.
- Seller agrees to indemnify and hold harmless CEC, its owners, shareholders, agents and employees, Rebecca Craft, and further agrees to make no claim or cross-claim against CEC, its owners, shareholders, agents, employees, Rebecca Craft, the lessor/lessee or owner of the space where the event is held, for any and all claims of personal injury and/or products liability stemming from the sellers participation in the consignment sale.
- The seller agrees to indemnify and hold harmless CEC, its owners, shareholders, agents and employees, Rebecca Craft for any and all claims of personal injury and/or products liability brought by third-parties relating to the purchase and/or use of sale item(s).
- The seller agrees to allow CEC to sell any accepted items brought to the sale on their behalf.
- The seller understands and agrees that CEC is an upscale consignment event and reserves the right to not accept any items that do not meet their requirements. CEC will check each item for quality during Drop-Off, however if anything is missed and later found during the sale, CEC has the right to pull it from the floor and not include in sale.
- Seller agrees they have read through the "items accepted", "item prep" and "tagging" sections of our website www.closetenvydfw.com and have followed all instructions on preparation of their items.
- If Seller selects "Discount" while loading their items into inventory in our online system and creating a tag for an item, Seller agrees and understands that unsold item will be offered for sale on the last day at 50% of the original sale price.

- Seller agrees and understands any unsold items selected as “Donate” will be donated to charity after the sale.
- Seller will receive 70% of the sales price on all items that are sold, unless otherwise stated in sales promotions, volunteering commitments, or CEC’s discretion.
- Sellers who volunteer and complete at least one 3-hour shift will earn 75% of their sales.
- Sellers understand and agree any unsold items must be picked up during the designated Pick-Up days/times and any items not picked up by Tuesday, June 9th at 6 pm become the property of CEC and may be donated. CEC is not responsible for storing any items after the sale. There will be NO exceptions!
- Any Seller who Volunteers understands and agrees they must complete their shift(s). If a Seller does not show up for their shift, without notice, a fee of \$25 will be deducted from their check and they will no longer be able to participate in future events, including Consigning, Volunteering, and Pre-Sales.
- CEC will promptly mail the Seller their earnings within 2 weeks of the end of sale, in the stamped/self-addressed envelope Seller provides at their Drop-Off appointment.
